ExecuJet Charter Service, Inc. Achieves Major Aviation Milestone with Approval of “10 or More Passenger” FAA Certification

With new certification, Tampa-Based ExecuJet can now charter any size or type of aircraft, including the new Gulfstream IV recently added to its fleet.

Tampa, Fla., March 28, 2011 – ExecuJet Charter Service, Inc. – based at the Tampa International Airport – as achieved a major milestone in the aviation community with its recent awarding of the FAA certification as a “10 or more passenger” charter service. This new FAA certification allows ExecuJet to charter any type or size aircraft, including the new Gulfstream IV that it has been managing and operating for the aircraft’s owner for the past 6 months. With the new certification, the Gulfstream IV officially becomes the eighth type of aircraft available for charter in the ExecuJet fleet of private airplanes.

In order to begin chartering the Gulfstream IV, ExecuJet had to petition the FAA for a new certification, which is only rewarded to those aviation providers who have proven “additional airworthiness standards for airplanes with 10 or more passenger seats” (FAA Federal Aviation Regulations). This certification was awarded to ExecuJet on March 21, 2011.

The Gulfstream IV is the largest aircraft in the ExecuJet fleet, and the only one of its kind in the Tampa Bay area now available for charter. What makes the Gulfstream IV even more unique is that it is the only aircraft in this area that can offer separate sleeping quarters on long-range flights.

The multi-million dollar Gulfstream IV has a stellar reputation as an intercontinental business aircraft. With a range of more than 4,800 miles, coast-to-coast and nonstop transoceanic flights are routine. This aircraft will safely and comfortably accommodate between 12 and 15 passengers and is equipped with two lavatories and both front and aft cabin space that can be separated for privacy.

With the addition of the Gulfstream IV, ExecuJet now has eight different types of aircraft for charter – the Gulfstream IV, the Falcon 50, Hawker 800XP, Hawker 800XP2, Hawker 800A, Hawker 700A, Westwind 1124 and the King Air 200.

For those wishing to see the Gulfstream IV in person, it will be on display this Friday (April 1) from 8 – 11 p.m. at the Festival of Speed Jetport Reception, taking place at the Tampa International Jet Center. Visit www.festivalspeed.com for more information.
