ExecuJet adds Gulfstream IV to fleet at TIA

ExecuJet Charter Service Inc. has added a Gulfstream IV to its fleet.

Following conformity inspection, the aircraft will be available as one of ExecuJet's fleet of eight aircraft for private charter.

The Gulfstream IV has a range of more than 4,800 miles and is capable of routine coast-to-coast and nonstop transoceanic flights, a release said.

The aircraft can accommodate between 12 and 15 passengers. It is the largest aircraft in the ExecuJet fleet, which also includes the Falcon 50, Hawker 800XP, Hawker 800XP2, Hawker 800A, Hawker 700A, Westwind 1124 and the King Air 200.

Based at **Tampa International Airport**, ExecuJet offers consulting, sales and acquisition, maintenance and management services, as well as aircraft charter.

The firm was founded in 1994 at the St. Petersburg – Clearwater Airport and relocated to the **Tampa International Jet Center** at TIA in 2006.
